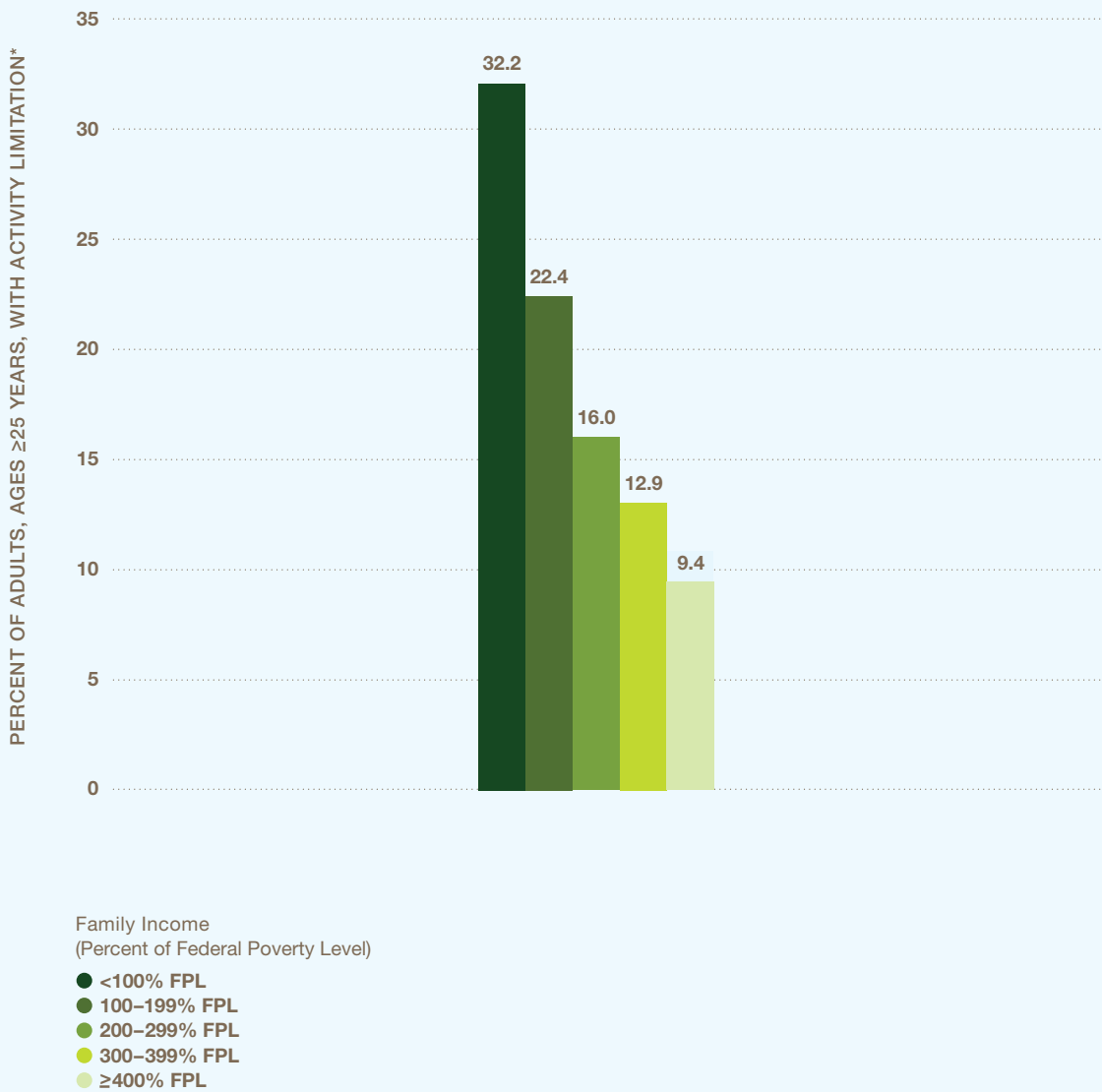


Lower Income, More Chronic Illness
